HUNT THE WUMPUS (answer) by Kenny Young

This is a six-level dungeon, with a Wumpus on every level. As with traditional Hunt the Wumpus, the game is played on the sides of an icosahedrons and there is a pit (though the pit drops you to the next level instead of killing you).

When you kill the wumpus, you get a cryptic clue.

Here is a chart of the interesting data:

The highlighted letters spell SAN FRANCISCO – this is part of the final clue.

What is also interesting is that each clue answer begins and ends with a pair of letters that matches the enter and exit of a different level – in fact, the clue answer can be spelled on that level by walking from room to room, and the shape of a letter appears if the dungeon level is mapped to an icosahedrons and the path is shaded.

New chart of the data:

Reading the path shapes in the order that the clues are given (P for NOMADIC, R for INTERLOCKS, etc.) gives the word PRISON.

The final clue is therefore SAN FRANCISCO PRISON, or ALCATRAZ.
